
Installation Instructions for Breathable® Mesh Crib Liner

Fits Four-Sided Slatted & Solid-Back Cribs | View installation video at breathablebaby.com



Fits four-sided slatted and solid-back cribs. Does not fit solid-end cribs or cribs with attached changing tables.

Care: For best results, machine wash warm, gentle cycle. Secure all fabric fasteners before laundering to avoid snagging. Wash separately or with like colors.

Only non-chlorine bleach when needed. Tumble dry low.


MWARNING

- To reduce the risk of SUFFOCATION:
- **Keep tight against side of crib.** Do not use if liner is loose or sags down toward sleeping surface.
- **Never put pillows or anything else in crib** that could trap baby against this liner.
- against this liner.

 Only use in a crib without broken parts or missing slats. This liner will not fix a broken rib or prevent baby from falling out. Never use in a toddler bed or bassiner.


 To help prevent ENTANGLEMENT or STRANGULATION, position ties to outside of crib and secure rightly.

Remove this liner when baby can pull to a stand using crib side (starting about 6 months). Older babies can use liner to climb out of crib.




Position Long Panel INSIDE Back of Crib

- 1. Center Long Panel INSIDE slats, along back of crib, as shown.
- 2. Make sure ties face UPWARDS and are OUTSIDE the crib.
- 3. In each corner (I and II), weave ends of Long Panel BEHIND the crib slats (a, b, c and d) so that liner passes in front of back corner posts.
- 4. Pull each end of Long Panel along slats inside the crib, toward the front corner posts (III and IV), as shown.




- 1st crib slat next to front corner post (III). Since crib slats vary in position and width, you may need to choose a different slat instead if it feels too loose or there seems to be extra material.
- 2. Secure around crib slat by pressing together top & bottom edges of Long Panel. Make sure there is a snug fit to prevent any sagging.
- 3. Repeat for other side (front corner post IV).
- 4. Tuck bottom edge of Long Panel below mattress.




Secure Ties of Long Panel

- 1. Center ties as best as possible on outside back of crib, knowing that crib slats may vary in position and width.
- Tightly tie all 3 ties OUTSIDE crib slats.
- 3. Make sure Long Panel stands up, pulling taut to tighten if it sags. It should not sag down.




Position Short Panel INSIDE Front of Crib

- 1. Center Short Panel INSIDE slats, along front of crib, as shown.
- 2. Make sure ties face UPWARDS and are OUTSIDE the crib.
- 3. In each corner (III and IV), weave ends of Short Panel BEHIND the crib slats (e, f, g and h) so that Short Panel passes in front of front corner posts.



- Short Panel. Make sure there is a snug fit to prevent any sagging.
- 3. Repeat for other side (front corner post IV).
- 4. Tuck bottom edge of Short Panel below mattress.



Secure Ties of Short Panel

- 1. Center ties as best as possible on outside front of crib, knowing that crib slats may vary in position and width.
- . Tightly tie all 3 ties OUTSIDE crib slats.
- 3. Make sure Short Panel stands up, pulling taut to tighten if it sags. It should not sag down.

Solid-Back Crib: Use Long Panel only to cover slatted long side of crib and both short sides.

- 1. Center Long Panel INSIDE slats, along front of crib,
- as shown. (You will not use the Short Panel.)

 2. Make sure ties face UPWARDS and are OUTSIDE
- 3. Follow **Step 2** and **Step 3** for weaving through slats and attaching ends of Long Panel to outside of crib. Because back of crib is solid, back corner posts will be uncovered by mesh.
